



Horse Transport Requirements

Attention Horse Owners, Buyers, Sellers and Carriers

Flying X Ranch horse transport requirements are the same as Wyoming **interstate** horse transport laws. You must have in your possession:

1. Valid (within one (1) year) Negative Coggins (EIA) test
2. Valid Veterinarian issued Horse Health Certificate
3. Valid Brand Inspection, **see Exception*

** Exception - For some states, for example Nebraska, a Health Certificate available from a veterinarian serves as the brand inspection/title of ownership.*

In addition, horses brought to the ranch must have proof of encephalomyelitis - eastern and western flu, rhino influenza, West Nile and tetanus vaccinations and worming at least two (2) weeks before arrival.

Upon horse(s) arrival at the Flying X Ranch, copies of the above mentioned documents must be filed with ranch management.

Note: Wyoming **intrastate** horse transport laws may differ from those listed above.
